Coach Engel spent his formative years in Wayland, MA before moving to College Station, TX to complete his high school education. Bill then made the trek north to play basketball at

Mesabi Community College, where he competed for long time Norse Coach Tom Stackpool. After leaving the Iron Range, Bill went on to complete his career at Valley City State University – earning a degree in Biology/Education and setting a single season record for 3 point percentage. Coach Engel also holds a Master’s degree in Sport Management from Texas A&M.

Since leaving Valley City State University, Coach Engel has been teaching high school science and coaching boys’ basketball for 19 years (14 years as a head coach) at Griggs County Central High School (Cooperstown, ND). In the last five years the GCCHS program was 75-33, has made numerous trips to the regional tournament and has been noted for stingy defense and a selfless style of play. Bill was also selected twice as the District 3 coach of the year and once as the Region 2 coach of the year.

The 2016-17 Voyageurs earned a trip to the Region XIII tournament finishing 20-8 – one of the best in school history. “It is our goal to consistently compete at the region and national level.” Coach Engel’s ultimate objective is to provide an opportunity for student athletes to grow as students, athletes, and individuals. Coach Engel said, “We want young men willing to give of themselves for the betterment of the team...we want individuals who want to go on to a four year school and ultimately will drive themselves to personal and professional excellence.”

Coach Engel has three children: Billy (23) Dickinson State University, Hunter (20) Unity College, and Mia (11).
